



US Lacrosse Data Access Application

US Lacrosse, Inc. ("USL") may provide personal identification and contact information of individual members of USL ("Membership Information"), to officers or other representatives of divisions, councils or chapters within USL to which those individual members belong or to program administrators who wish to enroll USL members into their programs ("Permitted Parties"). The undersigned represents that he or she is a Permitted Party and USL hereby grants access rights through the US Lacrosse Website (the "Access Rights") to such Membership Information as shall be necessary for the Permitted Party to complete his or her assigned tasks, upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Access Rights granted to the Permitted Party are personal to the Permitted Party, and shall be exercised solely by the Permitted Party. The Permitted Party shall not release to or otherwise allow any third party who is not a Permitted Party to have access to Membership Information without the express written consent of USL.
2. All Membership Information is proprietary to USL and the Permitted Party agrees to use the Membership Information solely for the purpose of administering the specified program or for an otherwise permitted purpose.
3. The Permitted Party warrants to US Lacrosse that all of the information provided by him or her to USL is accurate and complete in all respects.
4. The Access Rights shall remain in effect for 365 days from the date that the Permitted Party signs this application. USL reserves the right to revoke the Access Rights at any time and for any reason, as determined by USL in its sole discretion.
5. The Permitted Party will be notified via email if the Access Rights are granted. The Permitted Party must then establish an online account with USL (instructions will be included in the email).

Additional Program Administrators Agreements

As a program administrator of _____ (the "Program"), I hereby certify to US Lacrosse, Inc. ("USL"):

1. All members participating in the Program, including players, coaches or officials, have signed and delivered to myself (or otherwise to the Program) a membership agreement in the current form required by USL (a "Membership Agreement"), including the Waiver & Release, Consent to Medical Attention, Confirmation of Readiness to Compete and Code of Conduct; the parent or legal guardian of all Program participants who are not yet eighteen (18) years old have also signed a completed Membership Agreement.
2. Signed Membership Agreements for all Program participants will be either delivered to USL or retained by the Program for a period of six (6) years from the date that each Program participant reaches the age of eighteen (18) years old.
3. The Program and the undersigned individually agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless USL, its directors, officers, employees, agents, and contractors (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") against any loss or damage, including without limitation reasonable attorney's fees and defense costs, sustained by any of the Indemnified Parties as a result of any breach by the undersigned and/or the Program of any provision of this Agreement.
4. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Maryland, notwithstanding the actual residence of the parties. If any legal proceedings are commenced to enforce any provision of this Agreement, to seek a declaration of rights or as a result of any breach or threatened breach of any provision of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the non-prevailing party all of its costs and expenses incurred in connection with such proceedings, including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees.
5. The Program agrees that USL shall be entitled to take any other action deemed appropriate by USL with respect to preserving the rights and confidentiality of information, as determined by USL in its sole discretion.

US Lacrosse Data Access Agreement for Web Registration

In recognition of registration and member services that USL provides, the Program and its administrator(s) grant to USL all rights to use Membership Information and to contact Program members. By the signature of the undersigned, the Program is requesting that USL release Membership Information to third party web registration vendors as necessary to facilitate web registration of the Program members. Third party web vendors are limited in their access to member data for one year, after which this Agreement must be renewed. Third party web vendors sign agreements with USL that prevent vendors from sharing Membership Information with other outside entities and vendors may not solicit individual Program participants except for the purpose of facilitating registration. USL retains all rights to all Program and Membership Information indefinitely past the date that individual USL annual memberships of Program participants expire.
